Form of order sought

The applicant claims that the Court should:

- annul the contested decision:
- refers the trade mark at issue back to the EUIPO for examination;
- order EUIPO to pay the costs including the costs in the proceedings before the First Board of Appeal.

Pleas in law

- Infringement of Articles 4 and 7(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council;
- Infringement of Article 94 of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council;
- Infringement of the principles of proportionality and of equal treatment.
