- Infringement of Article 94 of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Article 296 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union;
- Infringement of Article 8(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council.
