## **OPINION**

## of the Advisory Committee on Concentrations given at the 56th meeting on 19 June 1998 concerning a preliminary draft decision relating to Case IV/M.1069 — WorldCom/MCI

(1999/C 122/04)

## (Text with EEA relevance)

The Advisory Committee agrees with the Commission:

- 1. that the proposed concentration constitutes a concentration within the meaning of Article 3(1)(a) of the Merger Regulation and that it has a Community dimension;
- 2. on the relevant product markets as defined in the draft Decision,
  - (a) that services and products related to the Internet are not substitutable for other types of data transmission,
  - (b) on the definition of product markets in relation to host to point of presence access services and to internet access services as defined in the draft Decision,
  - (c) that top level connectivity is not substitutable for connectivity offered by other types of ISPs and therefore constitutes a separate market in its own right,
  - (d) on the definition of the top level ISPs as described in the draft Decision;
- 3. on the relevant geographic markets as defined in the draft Decision;
- 4. on the competitive analysis as detailed in the draft Decision,
  - (a) that the proposed concentration does not raise competitive issues for markets other than the one for top level connectivity,
  - (b) on the relevance of the methods used by the Commission to assess market shares,
  - (c) that the proposed concentration will give to WorldCom/MCI a dominant position on the market for top level connectivity,
  - (d) that, subject to the identity of the purchaser, the remedies proposed by the parties are sufficient to counter the adverse effects of the notified operation,
  - (e) the Advisory Committee asks the Commission to proceed with the necessary assessment of the undertakings and to report on the results to the Member States;
- 5. that the concentration should be declared compatible with the common market pursuant to Article 8(2) of the Merger Regulation and with the functioning of the EEA Agreement;
- 6. the Committee recommends the Commission to take account of all the matters raised in the discussion;
- 7. the Committee agrees to the publication of the Advisory Committee's opinion.
