

COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) No 1139/2011**of 10 November 2011****amending Regulation (EU) No 204/2011 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 215 thereof,

Having regard to Council Decision 2011/729/CFSP of 10 November 2011 amending Decision 2011/137/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya ⁽¹⁾,

Having regard to the joint proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and the European Commission,

Whereas:

- (1) By Resolution 1973 (2011) of 17 March 2011, the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) decided that a ban should be imposed on flights in the airspace of Libya.
- (2) In application of Council Decision 2011/137/CFSP ⁽²⁾, that ban was given effect in the European Union by

Regulation (EU) No 204/2011 of 2 March 2011 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya ⁽³⁾.

- (3) By Resolution 2016 (2011) of 27 October 2011, the UNSC decided that the ban should be terminated.
- (4) Following Decision 2011/729/CFSP, the provision of Regulation (EU) No 204/2011 imposing the ban on flights should therefore be repealed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 4b of Regulation (EU) No 204/2011 is hereby deleted.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
