**Commission of the European Communities**

**v**

**Kingdom of Spain**

(Council Directive 83/183/EEC — National legislation which fails to comply with obligations under Community law)

Summary of the Judgment

*Member States — Obligations — Implementation of directives — Failure to implement — Justification — Not permissible*  
(EEC Treaty, Art. 169)

According to well-established case-law, a Member State may not plead provisions, practices or circumstances existing in its internal legal system in order to justify a failure to comply with obligations and time-limits laid down in Community directives.

OPINION OF THE ADVOCATE GENERAL

Mr Advocate General Tesauro delivered his Opinion on 14 February 1990.\* He proposed that the Court should uphold the application in the action brought against the Kingdom of Spain.
