COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1924/1999

of 8 September 1999

implementing Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98 on the organisation of a labour force sample survey in the Community as regards the 2000 to 2002 programme of *ad hoc* modules to the labour force survey

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98 of 9 March 1998 on the organisation of a labour force sample survey in the Community (1), and in particular Article 4(2) thereof,

- Whereas in accordance with Article 4(2) of Regulation (EC) No 577/98 a programme of *ad hoc* modules covering several years must be drawn up each year;
- (2) Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion delivered by the

Statistical Programme Committee established by Council Decision 89/382/EEC, Euratom (²),

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

A programme of *ad hoc* modules covering years 2000 to 2002 is laid down in the Annex to the present Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

LABOUR FORCE SURVEY

Multi-annual programme of ad hoc modules

1. Transition from school to working life

List of variables: see Commission Regulation (EC) No 1925/1999 on 8 September 1999 implementing Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98 on the organisation of a labour force sample survey in the Community concerning the specification of the 2000 *ad hoc* module on transition from school to working life (¹)

Reference period: second quarter 2000 (third quarter of 2000 of Italy)

Member States and regions concerned: all with exception of Germany

Sample: persons who had left education in the last five/ten years (including persons who have left education for at least one year and re-entered education subsequently); if the individual is the sample unit no information on the members of the household is requested

Transmission of the results: before 31 March 2001

2. Length and patterns of working time

List of variables: to be defined before March 2000

Reference period: second quarter 2001

Member States and regions concerned: to be defined

Sample: as for the standard modules; however, if the individual is the sample unit no information on the members of the household is requested

Transmission of the results: before 31 March 2002

3. Disabled people's employment

List of variables: to be defined before March 2001

Reference period: second quarter 2002

Member States and regions concerned: to be defined

Sample: disabled persons; if the individual is the sample unit no information on the members of the household is requested

Transmission of the results: before 31 March 2003
