Notice concerning anti-dumping measures on imports of ferro-silicon originating in the People's Republic of China, Kazakhstan, Russia and Ukraine

(2001/C 229/04)

By Commission Decision of 21 February 2001, the Commission terminated the anti-dumping proceeding concerning imports of ferro-silicon originating in Brazil, the People's Republic of China, Kazakhstan, Ukraine and Venezuela (¹).

An action against the Commission of the European Communities was brought before the Court of First Instance on 16 June 2001 by the Liaison Committee of the ferro-alloy industry ('Euroalliages') and others, seeking the annulment pursuant to Article 230 EC of the sole Article of Decision 2001/230/EC in so far as it concerned the People's Republic of China, Kazakhstan, Russia and the Ukraine: T132/01 Euroalliages and others v Commission of the European Communities.

In parallel, Euroalliages and others lodged a request before the Court of First Instance for interim measures pursuant to Articles 242 and 243 EC: T132/01R Euroalliages and others v Commission of the European Communities.

Notice is hereby given to Member States and to all interested parties that, on 1 August 2001, the President of the Court of First Instance ordered in case T132/01R Euroalliages and others v Commission of the European Communities that the imports of ferro-silicon (CN codes 7202 21 10; 7202 21 90; 7202 29 90) originating int the People's Republic of China, Kazakhstan, Russia and Ukraine be subject to registration without requiring a security to be provided by importers.
