Notice concerning the anti-dumping measures in force in respect of imports of certain prepared or preserved citrus fruits (namely mandarins, etc.) originating in the People's Republic of China: modification of the name of a company subject to the cooperating exporting producers' anti-dumping duty

Imports of certain prepared or preserved citrus fruits (namely mandarins, etc.) originating in the People's Republic of China are subject to definitive anti-dumping duties, imposed by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1313/2014 (¹).

Zhejiang Xinchang Best Foods Co. Ltd, a company located in the People's Republic of China, whose exports to the Union of certain prepared or preserved citrus fruits are subject to an anti-dumping duty of EUR 499,60 per tonne net product weight by the aforementioned Implementing Regulation, has informed the Commission that it has changed its name into Zhejiang Fomdas Foods Co., Ltd.

The company has asked the Commission to confirm that the change of name does not affect the right of the company to benefit from the individual duty rate applied to the company under its previous name of Zhejiang Xinchang Best Foods Co. Ltd.

The Commission has examined the information supplied and concluded that the change of name in no way affects the findings of Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1313/2014.

Therefore, the reference in the Annex to Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1313/2014 to:

'Zhejiang Xinchang Best Foods Co., Ltd'

should be read as:

'Zhejiang Fomdas Foods Co., Ltd'.

Zhejiang Fomdas Foods Co., Ltd shall be attributed the TARIC additional code A889 with the corresponding AD-duty amount of EUR 499,60 per tonne net product weight which was previously attributed to Zhejiang Xinchang Best Foods Co., Ltd.
