## MINUTES OF THE SITTING OF 18 JANUARY 2017

IN THE CHAIR: Antonio TAJANI

### 1. Opening of the sitting

The sitting opened at 9.00.

The President thanked the former President Martin Schulz and wished him success in his future political career in Germany.

The President noted that the number of candidates exceeded the number of seats to be filled. He recalled the provisions of Rule 17(1) and explained the procedure to the House.
