Prior notification of a concentration

(Case M.8689 — Rubis/Phillips 66/Zeller & Cie)

1. On 17 November 2017, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹).

This notification concerns the following undertakings:

- Rubis Terminal (France), belonging to the Rubis Group,

- Phillips 66 Central Europe Inc. (USA), belonging to the Phillips 66 Group,

— Zeller et Compagnie (France).

Rubis Terminal and Phillips 66 Central Europe Inc. acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) and 3(4) of the Merger Regulation joint control of the whole of Zeller et Compagnie.

The concentration is accomplished by way of purchase of shares.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for Rubis Terminal: storage of petroleum products, chemicals, agro-products and fertilizers in Europe,
- for Phillips 66 Central Europe Inc.: processing, transport, storage and marketing of gas and petroleum products globally,
- for Zeller et Compagnie: non-network sales of fuels, bitumen and oil and other petroleum products in Alsace and Grand Est region in France.

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
