

**Action brought on 31 January 2017 — Pegasus v Parliament****(Case T-57/17)**

*Language of the case: German***Parties***Applicant:* Pegasus (Brussels, Belgium) (represented by: P. Richter, lawyer)*Defendant:* European Parliament**Form of order sought**

The applicant claims that the Court should:

- annul Article I.4.1 of the defendant's decision of 12 December 2016 (Reference: FINS-2017-31) concerning the reduction of the pre-financing amount to 33 % of the specified maximum amount and ordering that a guarantee be lodged;
- order the defendant to pay the costs of the proceedings.

**Pleas in law and main arguments**In support of the action, the applicant relies on a single plea in law, which is in essence identical or similar to that raised in Case T-54/17, *CLF v Parliament*.
