

Notice concerning the provisional application of the Interim Partnership Agreement between the European Community, of one part, and the Pacific States, of the other part ⁽¹⁾

The European Union and Papua New Guinea have notified the completion of the procedures necessary for the provisional application of the Interim Partnership Agreement between the European Community, of one part, and the Pacific States, of the other part, in accordance with the Article 76 of that Agreement. Consequently the Agreement applies provisionally as from 20 December 2009 between the European Union and Papua New Guinea. On this date, pursuant to Article 4(2) of Council Regulation (EC) No 1528/2007 ⁽²⁾, Protocol II of the Agreement concerning the definition of the concept of 'originating products' supersedes the provisions contained in Annex II to the Regulation. On the same date, pursuant to Article 5(5) of Regulation (EC) No 1528/2007 the temporary suspension procedures set out in paragraphs 2 to 4 of Article 5 of the Regulation are superseded by those contained in Article 17 of the Agreement.
