

Notice of termination of the safeguard investigation initiated under Council Regulations (EC) No 260/2009 and (EC) No 625/2009, concerning imports of wireless wide area networking (WWAN) modems

(2011/C 24/09)

Further to a request from the Kingdom of Belgium, a safeguard investigation under Council Regulations (EC) No 260/2009 and (EC) No 625/2009, published in Notice 2010/C 171/07 and concerning imports of wireless wide area networking (WWAN) modems was initiated on 30 June 2010 ⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with the applicable provisions under Chapter III of Council Regulation (EC) No 260/2009 and Chapter III of Council Regulation (EC) No 625/2009, the Commission commenced an investigation procedure seeking to determine whether, as a result of unforeseen developments, WWAN modems are imported into the Union in such greatly increased quantities and/or on such terms or conditions as to cause, or threaten to cause, serious injury to the Union producers concerned.

On 29 October 2010, the Kingdom of Belgium withdrew its request for safeguard measures.

Considering that the request for safeguard measures has been withdrawn and taking into account the outcome of the consultation with the Member States, the Commission sees no reason to further pursue the present investigation. The safeguard investigation concerning imports of WWAN modems, initiated on 30 June 2010, shall hereby be terminated.
