[Your document, summarised – transcript]

In this video we will look at the main features of the 'Document summary' tab of the document page.

Many acts on EUR-Lex are summarised in a short, easy to understand text. There are several ways to access these summaries on the website. Clicking the 'Document summary' tab of your document is one of them.

At the top of the page, click on one of the icons to get the HTML version of the summary in the language of your choice.

You can also display up to three linguistic versions of the summary by using the 'multilingual display' tool. Select your languages in the drop-down menu and click on the 'Display' button.

The linguistic versions of the summary are displayed side by side.

Underneath the 'multilingual display' tool, you can see more information about the summary such as the dates of its initial creation and its last review, related subject areas and a link to the summarised document.

Finally, you can see the full text of the summary in the language of your interface. These summaries will allow you to grasp the key points of the act without reading the original act. They also provide information about key terms, related documents, and whether there is a consolidated version.
