


My RSS alerts use case 2: avian influenza

In this example we will show how to create an RSS alert on documents related to avian influenza.

1. Go to the [advanced search](#) page.

The link to the advanced search page is available at the top of every EUR-Lex page, just under the quick search.

2. On the advanced search page, go to the **Theme** box and click the plus button in the **EuroVoc thesaurus** field.

- avian influenza,
- veterinary inspection.

3. To find the above descriptors, type their names (e.g. avian influenza) in the search field at the top of the pop-up box. Then click the **Filter** button.

4. Tick the checkbox next to the EuroVoc descriptor you want to include in your search query and then click the **Select** button.

- Repeat the steps above for all the EuroVoc descriptors you need for this specific example.
- In this example, you do not need to tick the box next to **Include sub-levels of selected narrow terms** because the two descriptors 'avian influenza' and 'veterinary inspection' do not have sub-levels (narrower terms).
If you are not sure about the existence of sub-levels for a EuroVoc descriptor, we advise you to tick the box.

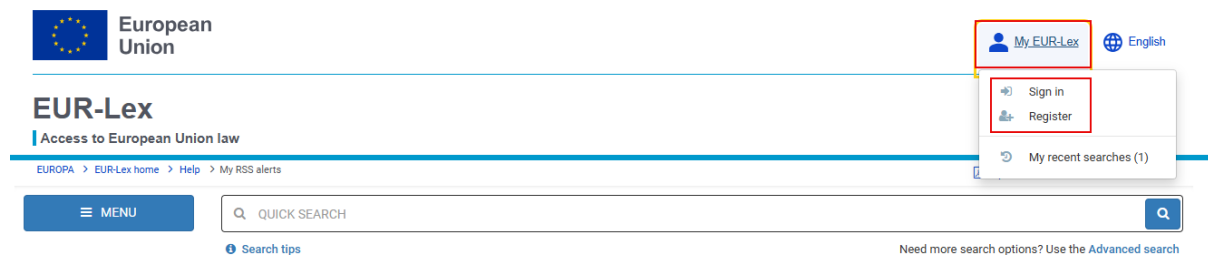
