Proprietor of the trade mark at issue: Applicant before the General Court

Trade mark at issue: European Union figurative mark (Representation of chevrons between two parallel lines) – European Union trade mark No 8 884 264

Procedure before EUIPO: Cancellation proceedings

Contested decision: Decision of the Grand Board of Appeal of EUIPO of 15 December 2023 in Case R 2672/2017-G (RENV)

Form of order sought

The applicant claims that the Court should:

- annul the contested decision;
- declare that the appeal is manifestly well founded;
- alternatively, that the cancellation application as it is based on Article 7(1)(a) and (b) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council is dismissed;
- order EUIPO and the interveners, if they take part in the proceedings, to pay the costs of the applicant for annulment, and bear their own costs.

Plea in law

- Infringement of Article 7(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council.
