Order of the General Court of 13 October 2023 — Fundacja Instytut na rzecz Kultury Prawnej Ordo Iuris v European Parliament

(Case T-42/21 RENV) ⁽¹⁾

(Action for annulment — Resolution of the Parliament on the de facto prohibition of the right to abortion in Poland — Act not amenable to review — Inadmissibility)

Parties

Applicant: Fundacja Instytut na rzecz Kultury Prawnej Ordo Iuris (Warsaw, Poland) (represented by: K. Koźmiński and T. Siemiński, lawyers)

Defendant: European Parliament (represented by: G. Corstens and W. Kuzmienko, acting as Agents)

Re:

By its action under Article 263 TFEU, the applicant seeks annulment of the European Parliament's resolution of 26 November 2020 on the de facto prohibition of the right to abortion in Poland [2020/2876(RSP)].

Operative part of the order

1. The action is dismissed as inadmissible;
2. Fundacja Instytut na rzecz Kultury Prawnej Ordo Iuris shall bear its own costs and pay those of the European Parliament in relation to the present proceedings and the proceedings in Cases T-42/21 and C-546/21 P.
