**Judgment of the Court of Justice (Seventh Chamber) of 12 September 2024 – Vincenzo D’Agostino,
Dafin Srl v European Central Bank**

(Case C-566/23 P) ⁽¹⁾

(Appeal – Action for damages – Statement by the President of the European Central Bank (ECB) at a press conference – Alleged damage arising from that statement – Decline in stock market indices – No infringement of rules of law intended to confer rights on individuals – Setting monetary policy objectives – Division of powers between the decision-making bodies of the ECB – Misuse of powers)
