



**Judgment of the General Court of 25 September 2024 – PT v Commission**

(Case T-367/22) (¹)

*(Civil service – Members of the contract staff – Retirement pension – Pension rights acquired before entry into the service of the European Union – Transfer to the EU scheme – Determination of pension rights – ‘Minimum subsistence figure’ rule – No reimbursement of transferred national pension rights – Plea of illegality – Fourth paragraph of Article 77 of the Staff Regulations – Equal treatment)*

**Re:**

By her action under Article 270 TFEU, the applicant seeks annulment of the decision of the European Commission of 4 October 2021 determining her retirement pension rights.

**Operative part of the judgment**

The Court:

1. Dismisses the action;
2. Orders PT to bear her own costs and to pay those incurred by the European Commission.
3. Declares that the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union are to bear their own costs.
