**Judgment of the General Court of 29 November 2023 — Asempre v Commission**

**(Case T-513/20) <sup>(1)</sup>**

***(Action for annulment — State aid — Postal service — Compensation for universal postal service — Professional association — Lack of individual concern — No substantial effect on the competitive position — Inadmissibility)***

**Re:**

By its action under Article 263 TFEU, the applicant seeks the annulment of Commission Decision C(2020) 3108 final of 14 May 2020, concerning State aid SA.50872 (2020/NN) — Compensation to Correos under the universal service obligation, 2011-2020.

**Operative part of the judgment**

The Court:

1. Dismisses the action as inadmissible;
2. Orders the Asociación Profesional de Empresas de Reparto y Manipulado de Correspondencia (Asempre) to bear its own costs and to pay those incurred by the European Commission and by Sociedad Estatal Correos y Telégrafos, SA.
3. Orders the Kingdom of Spain to bear its own costs.
