Re:

By its action under Article 263 TFEU, the applicant seeks the annulment of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2023/111 of 18 January 2023 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of fatty acid originating in Indonesia (OJ 2023, L 18, p. 1).

Operative part of the judgment

The Court:

1. Dismisses the action;
2. Orders Arkema France to bear its own costs.
