Question referred

Are dairy products which are intended to be used as the raw materials for animal feed and in which residues of chloramphenicol have been found considered not to satisfy the feed safety requirements within the meaning of Article 20(1) and/or (3) of Regulation [No] 178/2002 ⁽¹⁾? Based on which provision(s) are they then considered not to satisfy those requirements?
