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MINUTES OF THE SITTING OF 16 JUNE 2025

IN THE CHAIR: Roberta METSOLA

President

1. Resumption of the session

The session adjourned on Thursday 22 May 2025 was resumed.

2. Opening of the sitting

The sitting opened at 17:00.

3. Statements by the President

The President made a statement on the school shooting carried out the previous week in Graz, Austria, by a former pupil, in which 10 people were killed and many others injured.

She also made reference to the murder of a teaching assistant outside a school in Nogent, France, which had taken place the same day.

The President expressed her sympathies to the victims and their loved ones on behalf of Parliament.

Parliament observed a minute's silence.

4. Approval of the minutes of the previous sittings

The minutes of the sittings of 21 May 2025 and 22 May 2025 were approved.

5. Composition of Parliament

Ondřej Kovařík had tendered his resignation as a Member of the European Parliament with effect from 31 July 2025.

The JURI Committee considered this resignation to be in line with the Act of 20 September 1976 concerning the election of the members of the European Parliament by direct universal suffrage.

In accordance with Rule 4, Parliament established the vacancy as of 31 July 2025 and informed the national authorities concerned.

6. Requests for the waiver of immunity

The competent Polish authorities had sent the President a request for Grzegorz Braun's immunity to be waived in connection with legal proceedings in Poland.

Pursuant to Rule 9(1), the request had been referred to the committee responsible, in this case the JURI Committee.

7. Requests for the waiver of immunity – termination of procedure

The competent authorities of Belgium had addressed a letter to the President withdrawing the request for the waiver of the immunity of Giusi Princi, announced in plenary on 21 May 2025 (*minutes of 21.5.2025, item 12*).

Consequently, this procedure on the waiver of immunity was closed.

8. Requests for the defence of the immunity of a former Member – termination of procedure

The JURI Committee, which is the committee responsible, had informed the President that the request for the defence of the immunity of Helmut Geuking, announced in plenary on 10 March 2025 (*minutes of 10.3.2025, item 14*), was inadmissible under Rule 9(8).

Consequently, this procedure was closed.

9. Composition of political groups

Fernand Kartheiser was no longer a member of the ECR Group and had been sitting as a non-attached Member as of 4 June 2025.

10. Composition of committees and delegations

The ECR Group had notified the President of the following decision changing the composition of the committees and delegations:

— Delegation to the EU-Russia Parliamentary Cooperation Committee: Maciej Wąsik

The decision took effect as of that day.

11. Interpretations of the Rules of Procedure

The President informed Parliament, in accordance with Rule 242(3), of the following interpretations of the Rules provided by the AFCO Committee:

Interpretation of Article 3(5), first subparagraph, of Annex I — Declaration on awareness of conflicts of interest in relation to standing rapporteurs:

A Member who is proposed as rapporteur for several files with a similar subject matter may submit a general declaration covering all those files on a voluntary basis. If such a general declaration is not submitted, a declaration must be submitted for each individual file. Where a general declaration has been submitted and a conflict of interest arises for an individual file, a declaration must be submitted for that individual file.

Interpretation of Article 3(5), first subparagraph, of Annex I — Declaration on awareness of conflicts of interest in the context of the verification of credentials:

In the case of reports on the verification of credentials of newly elected Members provided for in Rule 3(3) of the Rules of Procedure, the rapporteur must declare a conflict of interest with regard to the verification of his or her own credentials. This obligation is without prejudice to his or her obligation to declare other conflicts of interest.

Interpretation of Article 8 of Annex I:

The provisions of Article 8 on the declaration of input do not apply to the reports provided for in Rule 8(2) and Rule 9(4), (7) and (9) of the Rules of Procedure in the context of procedures relating to the immunity of a Member.

Interpretations contested by a political group or Members reaching at least the low threshold within a period of 24 hours following their announcement would be put to the vote, in accordance with Rule 242(4). Uncontested interpretations would be appended as explanatory notes.

12. Negotiations ahead of Parliament's first reading (Rule 72)

The committee responsible had decided to enter into interinstitutional negotiations on the basis of the following report:

A request for a roll-call vote on the decision could be tabled before midnight the following day, 17 June 2025.

Negotiations could start at any time after the expiry of that deadline if no request for a vote on the decision to enter into negotiations had been made.

If no objections were raised by a political group or a number of Members reaching at least the low threshold within 24 hours of this announcement, the recommendation would be deemed approved. If objections were raised, it would be put to the vote.
