Form of order sought

The applicant claims that the Court should:

- to annul and, as the case may be, to alter the contested decision and to declare the invalidity of the trademark at issue in its entirety;
- to order the EUIPO and the other party to the proceedings before the Board of Appeal, in case the latter decides to intervene in these proceedings, to bear their own costs;
- to order the EUIPO and the other party to the proceedings before the Board of Appeal, in case that the latter decides to intervene, to pay the costs incurred by the Applicant.

Pleas in law

- Infringement of Article 59(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council;
- Infringement of Article 60(1)(a) in conjunction with Article 8(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council;
- Infringement of Article 59(1)(a) in conjunction with Article 7(1)(g) of Regulation (EU) 2017/1001 of the European Parliament and of the Council;
- Infringement of Article 71(1)(b) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2018/625.
