COMMISSION DECISION

of 19 December 1963

amending the Commission Decision of 17 May 1963 setting up a Joint Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Paid Agricultural Workers

(64/19/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY,

Whereas in view of the setting up, by Decision of today's date, of an 'Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Farmers' and the existence of a 'Joint Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Paid Agricultural Workers', set up by the Decision of 17 May 1963,¹ it appears necessary to provide that both Committees take into account the repercussions on the agricultural world in general of specific questions which they are required to deal with in carrying out their respective tasks;

Whereas for that reason Article 2 of the Commission Decision of 17 May 1963 should be amended accordingly, in order to include therein the further provisions in this respect contained in the Decision of today's date setting up an 'Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Farmers';

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The sixth recital of the Decision of 17 May 1963 setting up a Joint Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Paid Agricultural Workers shall be amended to read as follows:

'Whereas the outcome of that discussion was that such Joint Committee should enable the Commission to obtain the views of the representative bodies of agricultural employers and paid agricultural workers on the social questions of concern to the two sides of the industry, all these questions being considered both specifically and with regard to their repercussions on the agricultural population as a whole.'

Article 2

The first paragraph of Article 2 of that Decision shall be amended to read as follows:

'The Committee may be consulted by the Commission on all social questions of concern to the two sides, employers and employees, of the agricultural industry, all these problems being considered both specifically and with regard to their repercussions on the agricultural population as a whole.'
