## COUNCIL DECISION

of 28 April 1975

on the conclusion of the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the World Food Programme on the supply of skimmed-milk powder to developing countries as food aid

(75/348/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Articles 113, 114 and 228 thereof;

Having regard to the recommendation from the Commission;

Whereas, under Regulation (EEC) No 1827/74<sup>(1)</sup>, the Council decided to make 20 000 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder available to the World Food Programme;

Whereas the object of the World Food Programme is to make use of contributions received under the Programme to meet emergency food requirements and to carry out projects involving the use of food-stuffs to promote economic and social development;

Whereas it may happen in certain cases that delivery is made at a stage corresponding to the fob stage; whereas in such cases the arrangements for delivery and acceptance of delivery at this stage will have to be determined rapidly,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

*Article 1*

The Agreement between the European Economic Community and the World Food Programme on the supply of skimmed-milk powder to developing countries as food aid is hereby concluded on behalf of the European Economic Community.

The text of the Agreement is annexed to this Decision.

*Article 2*

The President of the Council is hereby authorized to designate the persons empowered to sign the Agreement and to confer on them the powers necessary to bind the Community.
