

COUNCIL DECISION
of 19 December 1977
appointing a member of the Advisory Committee on Safety, Hygiene and Health
Protection at Work

(78/56/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to the Council Decision of 27 June
1974 on the setting up of an Advisory Committee on
Safety, Hygiene and Health Protection at Work ⁽¹⁾,
and in particular Article 4 thereof,

Having regard to the Council Decision of 5 May 1975
appointing the members and alternate members of
the Advisory Committee on Safety, Hygiene and
Health Protection at Work for the period ending on 4
May 1978,

Whereas a seat as member in the Government repre-
sentatives category of the Advisory Committee on
Safety, Hygiene and Health Protection at Work has
fallen vacant following the resignation of Mr
O'Riordan, notified to the Council on 12 December
1977;

Having regard to the candidate proposed by the Irish
Government on 12 December 1977,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS :

Sole Article

Mr M. Cashell is hereby appointed a member of the
Advisory Committee on Safety, Hygiene and Health
Protection at Work in place of Mr O'Riordan for the
remainder of the latter's term of office, which runs
until 4 May 1978.
