

COMMISSION DECISION

of 29 January 1996

**amending Decision 94/86/EC drawing up a provisional list of third countries
from which Member States authorize imports of wild game meat**

(Text with EEA relevance)

(96/137/EC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION :

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Directive 92/45/EEC of 16 June 1992 on public health and animal health problems relating to the killing of wild game and the placing on the market of wild game meat⁽¹⁾, as last amended by the Act of Accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden, and in particular Article 16 (2) and (3) thereof,

Whereas Commission Decision 94/86/EC⁽²⁾ established a provisional list of third countries from which importation of wild game meat is authorized;

Whereas it is necessary to adapt Decision 94/86/EC to take into account amendments in Community legislation referred to by it;

Whereas further written assurances have been received from Tunisia; whereas examination of these assurances has shown that this country satisfies the requirements of the Community;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary Committee,

Article 1

Part I of the Annex to Decision 94/86/EC is replaced by the following:

'PART I

List of countries from which Member States shall authorize imports of wild feathered game meat:

- the list of third countries from which Member States authorize imports of fresh poultry meat appearing in Commission Decision 94/85/EC^(*),
- Greenland,
- Tunisia.
