

**DECISION (EU) 2023/328 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT****of 22 November 2022****on the closure of the accounts of the European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) for the financial year 2020**

THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT,

- having regard to the final annual accounts of the European Border and Coast Guard Agency for the financial year 2020,
- having regard to the Court of Auditors' annual report on EU agencies for the financial year 2020, together with the agencies' replies <sup>(1)</sup>,
- having regard to the statement of assurance <sup>(2)</sup> as to the reliability of the accounts and the legality and regularity of the underlying transactions provided by the Court of Auditors for the financial year 2020, pursuant to Article 287 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
- having regard to the Council's recommendation of 28 February 2022 on discharge to be given to the Agency in respect of the implementation of the budget for the financial year 2020 (06003/2022 – C9-0101/2022),
- having regard to its decision of 4 May 2022 <sup>(3)</sup> postponing the discharge decision for the financial year 2020, and the replies from the Executive Director of the European Border and Coast Guard Agency,
- having regard to its decision of 18 October 2022 <sup>(4)</sup> refusing to grant the Executive Director of the European Border and Coast Guard Agency discharge for the financial year 2020,
- having regard to Article 319 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
- having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 <sup>(5)</sup>, and in particular Article 70 thereof,
- having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/1896 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 November 2019 on the European Border and Coast Guard and repealing Regulations (EU) No 1052/2013 and (EU) 2016/1624 <sup>(6)</sup>, and in particular Article 116 thereof,
- having regard to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/715 of 18 December 2018 on the framework financial regulation for the bodies set up under the TFEU and Euratom Treaty and referred to in Article 70 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council <sup>(7)</sup>, and in particular Article 105 thereof,
- having regard to Rule 100 of, and Annex V to, its Rules of Procedure,

1. Approves the closure of the accounts of the European Border and Coast Guard Agency for the financial year 2020;
