COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION (EU) 2026/1736

of 14 July 2026

**on harmonised standards for digital product passports drafted in support of Regulation
(EU) 2024/1781 of the European Parliament and of the Council**

(Text with EEA relevance)

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 1025/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on European standardisation, amending Council Directives 89/686/EEC and 93/15/EEC and Directives 94/9/EC, 94/25/EC, 95/16/EC, 97/23/EC, 98/34/EC, 2004/22/EC, 2007/23/EC, 2009/23/EC and 2009/105/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Council Decision 87/95/EEC and Decision No 1673/2006/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 10(6) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In accordance with Article 41(2) of Regulation (EU) 2024/1781 of the European Parliament and of the Council ⁽²⁾, digital product passports which are in conformity with harmonised standards or parts thereof, the references of which have been published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*, are to be presumed to be in conformity with the requirements set out in Articles 10 and 11 of that Regulation covered by those harmonised standards or parts thereof.
- (2) By Commission Implementing Decision C(2024) 5423 ⁽³⁾, as amended by Implementing Decision C(2025) 8024 ⁽⁴⁾, the Commission made a request to the CEN, Cenelec and ETSI for drafting harmonised standards in support of the requirements that are set out in Article 10 and Article 11 of Regulation (EU) 2024/1781 ('the request').
- (3) On the basis of the request, CEN, Cenelec and ETSI drafted harmonised standards EN 18216:2026, EN 18219:2026, EN 18220:2026, EN 18221:2026, EN 18222:2026, and EN 18223:2026 for digital product passports in support of Regulation (EU) 2024/1781.
- (4) The Commission, together with CEN, Cenelec and ETSI, has assessed whether harmonised standards EN 18216:2026, EN 18219:2026, EN 18220:2026, EN 18221:2026, EN 18222:2026 and EN 18223:2026 comply with the request.
- (5) Harmonised standards EN 18216:2026, EN 18219:2026, EN 18220:2026, EN 18221:2026, EN 18222:2026 and EN 18223:2026 satisfy the requirements set out in Articles 10 and 11 of Regulation (EU) 2024/1781. It is therefore appropriate to publish the references of those harmonised standards in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
- (6) Compliance with a harmonised standard confers a presumption of conformity with the corresponding essential requirements, set out in Union harmonisation legislation from the date of publication of the reference of such standard in the *Official Journal of the European Union*. This Decision should therefore enter into force on the day of its publication,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The references of harmonised standards for digital product passports drafted in support of Regulation (EU) 2024/1781, listed in the Annex to this Decision, are hereby published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
