

REGULATION (EEC) No 1637/71 OF THE COMMISSION

of 28 July 1971

amending Regulation No 158/67/EEC determining the coefficients of equivalence between the different qualities of cereals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1528/71,² and in particular Article 13 (4) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation No 158/67/EEC³ of 23 June 1967, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2204/69⁴ of 5 November 1969, determined the coefficients of equivalence between the qualities of cereals offered on the world market and the standard quality for which the threshold price is fixed;

Whereas, as the result of a new system of grading for common wheat in Canada, wheat of the type No 1 Canada Western Red Spring not listed in the Annex

to Regulation No 158/67/EEC has for some time been on offer;

Whereas, with a view to determining c.i.f. prices, it is necessary to fix coefficients of equivalence for that quality with different protein contents, taking into account the standard Community quality on the one hand, and the differences in price and characteristics between that quality and the qualities listed in the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC on the other;

Whereas comparison between certain qualities of common wheat from the United States and Australia offered on the world market, and the standard quality for which the threshold price is fixed, has shown that the coefficients of equivalence fixed by Regulation No 158/67/EEC must be revised for those qualities taking account of the price disparities in the qualities offered and of the characteristics of those qualities;

Whereas the measures provided for in the Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following shall be substituted for the 'Common wheat' section of the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC:
