REGULATION (EEC) No 1088/72 OF THE COMMISSION

of 26 May 1972

on the exchange of quantitative information between Member States and the Commission
regarding imports and exports of barley, malt, maize and rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organization of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2727/71,² and in particular Article 24 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC³ of 25 July 1967 on the common organization of the market in rice, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2726/71,⁴ and in particular Article 25 thereof;

Whereas the management of the cereal market requires a close watch to be kept on developments in both import and export markets; whereas information on the quantities of rice, cereals and certain products resulting from the processing of cereals for which licences have been issued is not enough in the present economic situation; whereas information on effective Community imports and exports consequently becomes a determining factor in the management of the cereals market, and whereas, for that purpose, it is sufficient to know the quantities imported or exported subject to levies or refunds in accordance with Regulations Nos 120/67/EEC and 359/67/EEC;

Whereas information on effective imports and exports of wheat and wheat flour is already supplied to the Commission by Member States; whereas such information should also be supplied in respect of products such as barley, malt, maize and rice;

Whereas it is essential for the purposes referred to above that information regarding imports and exports should be sent to the Commission as quickly as possible; whereas, if information received from Member States is to be readily usable, it should be supplied in a standard form;

Whereas, in order that Member States may be properly informed of the situation on the Community market, all information received should be forwarded to them regularly;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. Member States shall inform the Commission by telex, under the headings set out in the Annexes, of the quantities of barley, malt, maize, barley and maize seed, and husked, semi-milled, wholly milled and broken rice, imported from and exported to third countries from the first to the tenth, eleventh to the twentieth and twenty-first to the last day of each month.

This information shall be sent to the Commission not later than the eighth day following the end of each of the periods referred to above. If the eighth day is not a working day, the information shall be sent on the first working day following that date.

2. Fifty days after the end of each month a revised statement of imports to and exports from third countries during that month of the products referred to above shall also be sent to the Commission in the form in the Annexes.

Article 2

At the end of each month, and for the first time at the end of the third month following the entry into force of this Regulation, the Commission shall provide Member States with a summary of import and export movements based on the information received.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 August 1972 except as regards rice, for which it shall enter into force on 1 September 1972.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
