

**REGULATION (EEC) No 1058/73 OF THE COMMISSION**  
**of 18 April 1973**

**authorizing Ireland to suspend in part the customs duties on fillets of fish, uncooked, breaded and frozen falling within tariff subheading ex 16.04 G of the Common Customs Tariff imported from other Member States of the European Economic Community**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty<sup>(1)</sup> concerning the Accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972, and in particular Article 59 (4) of the Act annexed thereto ;

Whereas Article 59 (4) of the Act provides that, in respect of products covered by a common organization of the market, the new Member States may be authorized to suspend in whole or in part the customs duties on products imported from other Member States ;

Whereas the Government of Ireland has applied for the partial suspension during the remainder of 1973 of the customs duties on fillets of fish, uncooked, breaded and frozen falling within subheading ex 16.04 G of the Common Customs Tariff ;

Whereas trade between Member States will benefit from this suspension and whereas the request should therefore be granted ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Fishery Products ;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

*Article 1*

Ireland is authorized to suspend until 31 December 1973 the customs duty it applies on imports of fillets of fish, uncooked, breaded and frozen falling within tariff subheading ex 16.04 G of the Common Customs Tariff

- by reducing the duty to 20 % on such products coming from the United Kingdom,
- by reducing the duty to 30 % on such products coming from other Member States of the European Economic Community.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
