REGULATION (EEC) No 1824/73 OF THE COUNCIL**of 6 July 1973****supplementing Regulation (EEC) No 1695/73 as regards the application of monetary compensatory amounts for calves and young bovine animals in the new Member States**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 ⁽¹⁾ of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture following the temporary widening of the margins of fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member States, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1225/73 ⁽²⁾ and in particular the second subparagraph of Article 4a (2) thereof ;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission ;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1659/73 ⁽³⁾ of 25 June 1973 determining to what extent the monetary compensatory amounts applicable to beef and veal by reason of the depreciation of a currency may be higher than the charge on imports from third countries, has limited the application of Article 4a (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 on calves and young bovine animals referred to in Article 11 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 ⁽⁴⁾ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 187/73 ⁽⁵⁾ ;

Whereas this limitation does not take account of the special situation in the new Member States not yet applying the Common Customs Tariff ; for that reason it should be provided that in that case the limitation of the monetary compensatory amounts, arising from the application of Article 4a (2) first subparagraph, of Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 does not apply to this case ;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1695/73 the following paragraph shall be added :

'3. Notwithstanding paragraphs 1 and 2, Article 4a (2), first subparagraph of Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 shall not be applicable to the amounts to be granted or levied for calves and young bovine animals, referred to in Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68, in the new Member States, not yet applying the Common Customs Tariff.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 9 July 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
