

REGULATION (EEC) No 1967/73 OF THE COUNCIL

of 17 July 1973

amending Regulation (EEC) No 229/73 as regards the 'accession' compensatory amounts and coefficients to be applied thereto for cereals

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to the Treaty ⁽¹⁾ concerning the Accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972, and in particular Article 62 (1) of the Act annexed thereto ;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission ;

Whereas the compensatory amounts which are applicable until 31 July 1973 for common wheat and barley were fixed by Article 1 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 229/73 ⁽²⁾ of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for the system of compensatory amounts for cereals and determining these for certain products ; whereas, in accordance with Article 55 (2) of the Act of Accession, these amounts correspond to the difference between prices established for the new Member State concerned and the common prices ;

Whereas, in accordance with Article 52 of the Act of Accession the prices established for new Member States must be aligned with the level of the common prices in six stages ; whereas, for the marketing year 1973/74, the result of this alignment is the prices for common wheat and barley that are dealt with in Council Regulation (EEC) No 1927/73 ⁽³⁾ of 16 July 1973 determining, for the marketing year 1973/74, the main marketing centres for cereals, the derived intervention prices applicable at those centres, and the single intervention prices for maize, durum wheat and rye ; whereas, in accordance with Article 55 (2) of the Act, the difference between these prices and the common prices constitutes the 'accession'

compensatory amount that is valid for the new marketing year ;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 229/73 did not determine compensatory amounts for those cereals for which no derived intervention price has been fixed, but coefficients for the compensatory amount applicable to the reference cereal ; whereas under Article 2 (2) of the above Regulation the coefficients are to be progressively aligned ;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Article 1 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 229/73 is replaced by the following :

'Article 1

The compensatory amounts applicable until 31 July 1974 in trade between the Community as originally constituted and the new Member States, and between the new Member States and third countries, shall, for the following cereals, be as follows :

Article 2

Article 2 (1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 229/73 is replaced by the following :

'The compensatory amounts applicable until 31 July 1974 in trade between the Community as originally constituted and the new Member States,

and between the new Member States and third countries, shall be calculated by applying the

following coefficients to the compensatory amounts for the reference cereal :

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 August 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
