

REGULATION (EEC) No 2301/73 OF THE COMMISSION**of 23 August 1973****amending Regulation (EEC) No 2141/73 on a period during which tenders may be submitted in response to the invitation to tender of sugar for export**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 1009/67/EEC⁽¹⁾ of 18 December 1967 on the common organization of the market in sugar, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1928/73⁽²⁾, and in particular Articles 11 (2) and 17 (4) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2141/73⁽³⁾ of 3 August 1973 on a standing invitation to tender to determine the export refund for white sugar requires Member States to issue partial invitations to tender for the export of white sugar; whereas in consideration of administrative reasons it should be necessary to change for one of them the date of the end of the period during which tenders may be submitted;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Sugar;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 4 (3) (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 2141/73 is replaced by the following:

'(a) On Wednesday, 5 September 1973 and Wednesday 21 November 1973, shall end at 10 a.m. respectively on Thursday, 6 September 1973, and on Tuesday, 20 November 1973;'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 24 August 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
