

REGULATION (EEC) No 2935/73 OF THE COMMISSION
of 26 October 1973
fixing the compensatory amounts for eggs

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty⁽¹⁾ concerning the Accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 237/73⁽²⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2880/73⁽³⁾, of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for the system of compensatory amounts for eggs, and in particular Article 9 (3) thereof;

Whereas the compensatory amounts for egg products were fixed by Council Regulation (EEC) No 237/73 and Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2053/73⁽⁴⁾ of 25 July 1973; whereas, however, the compensatory amounts are determined in accordance with Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 237/73 where the situation envisaged in Article 7 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 229/73⁽⁵⁾ of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for the system of compensatory amounts for cereals arises;

Whereas in the sector of eggs the calculation of the compensatory amounts for trade with Denmark results in minimal amounts; whereas there is therefore no need to fix compensatory amounts,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The amounts provided for in Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 237/73 as compensatory amounts for eggs, ovalbumin and lactalbumin for the period 1 November 1973 to 31 January 1974 are fixed in the Annex.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 November 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
