

REGULATION (EEC) No 3039/73 OF THE COMMISSION
of 8 November 1973

closing the standing invitation to tender for the purpose of determining denaturing premiums for white sugar for feeding to bees provided for in Regulation (EEC) No 2711/73

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 1009/67/EEC⁽¹⁾ of 18 December 1967 on the common organization of the market in sugar, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1928/73⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 9 (8) thereof ;

Whereas, Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2711/73⁽³⁾ of 4 October 1973 on the opening of a standing invitation to tender for the purpose of determining denaturing premiums for white sugar for feeding to bees provides that the Member States are to issue partial invitations to tender for the purpose of determining the said premiums ; whereas the above-mentioned standing invitation to tender should be closed ;

Whereas the measures laid down in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Sugar,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The standing invitation to tender provided for in Regulation (EEC) No 2711/73 is hereby closed on 15 November 1973.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
