

REGULATION (EEC) No 3122/73 OF THE COMMISSION
of 16 November 1973
amending Regulation (EEC) No 2734/73 on the sale of butter held by the inter-
vention agencies

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 ⁽¹⁾ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products, as last amended by the Act ⁽²⁾ concerning the Conditions of Accession and the Adjustments to the Treaties, and in particular Article 6 (7) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2734/73 ⁽³⁾ of 8 October 1973 on the sale of butter held by the intervention agencies is applicable only until 15 November 1973;

Whereas there are still possibilities for disposing of quantities of butter exceeding those available in the trade on normal market terms, in order to permit interested parties to continue to obtain supplies from

the intervention agencies, therefore it is necessary to extend the validity of the aforementioned Regulation;

Whereas the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products has not delivered an Opinion within the time limit set by its Chairman,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 2734/73, the date '15 November 1973' is replaced by '31 January 1974'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It is applicable from 15 November 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
