

REGULATION (EEC) No 82/73 OF THE COMMISSION

of 15 January 1973

altering the refunds on white sugar and raw sugar exported in the natural state

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 1009/67/EEC ⁽¹⁾ of 18 December 1967 on the common organization of the market in sugar, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2429/72 ⁽²⁾, and in particular the second sentence of the sixth subparagraph of Article 17 (2) thereof ;

Whereas the refunds on white sugar and raw sugar exported in the natural state were fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 24/73 ⁽³⁾ ;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules, criteria and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 24/73 to the information at present available

to the Commission that the export refunds at present in force should be altered as shown in the Annex to this Regulation ;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The refunds on the products listed in Article 1 (1) (a) of Regulation No 1009/67/EEC, undenatured and exported in the natural state, as fixed in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 24/73, are hereby altered as shown in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 16 January 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
