

REGULATION (EEC) No 1170/74 OF THE COMMISSION

of 8 May 1974

altering the import levies on products processed from cereals and rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC⁽¹⁾ of 13 June 1967 on the common organization of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1346/73⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 14 (4) thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC⁽³⁾ of 25 July 1967 on the common organization of the market in rice, as last amended by the Act⁽⁴⁾ annexed to the Treaty⁽⁵⁾ on the Accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972, and in particular Article 12 (4) thereof;

Whereas the import levies on products processed from cereals and rice were fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 1041/74⁽⁶⁾; as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1169/74⁽⁷⁾;

Whereas the levy on the basic product as last fixed differs from the average levy by more than 0.25 unit of account per 100 kilogrammes of basic product; whereas, pursuant to Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1080/68⁽⁸⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1047/73⁽⁹⁾, the levies at present in force must therefore be altered as shown in the Table annexed to this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The import levies to be charged on products processed from cereals and rice covered by Regulation (EEC) No 1052/68⁽¹⁰⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 881/73⁽¹¹⁾, as fixed in the Annex to amended Regulation (EEC) No 1041/74 are hereby altered as shown in the Table annexed to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 9 May 1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

⁽¹⁾ For the purpose of distinguishing between products falling within headings Nos 11.01 and 11.02 and those falling within subheading 23.02 A, products falling within heading Nos 11.01 and 11.02 shall be those meeting the following specifications :

- a starch content (determined by the modified Ewers polarimetric method), referred to dry matter, exceeding 45 % by weight
- an ash content, by weight, referred to dry matter (after deduction of any added minerals), not exceeding 1.6 % for rice, 2.5 % for wheat, 3 % for barley, 4 % for buckwheat, 5 % for oats and 2 % for other cereals.

Germ of cereals, whole, rolled, flaked or ground, falls in all cases within heading No 11.02.
