

REGULATION (EEC) No 1689/74 OF THE COMMISSION

of 28 June 1974

fixing accession compensatory amounts for the 1974/75 sugar marketing year

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty⁽¹⁾ concerning the accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 241/73⁽²⁾ of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for the system of compensatory amounts for sugar following the accession of new Member States to the Community, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1638/73⁽³⁾, and in particular Article 2 (a) thereof;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1600/74⁽⁴⁾ of 29 April 1974 fixing, for the 1974/75 marketing year, the derived intervention prices, the intervention prices for raw beet sugar, the minimum prices for beet, the threshold prices, and the maximum amount of the production levy, fixed for Ireland and the United Kingdom prices different from the level of common prices; whereas under Article 2 (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 241/73, the subsequent fixing of the accession compensatory amounts should therefore be effected in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 40 of Council Regulation No 1009/67/EEC⁽⁵⁾ of 18 December 1967 on the common organization of the market in sugar, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1602/74⁽⁶⁾;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with Opinion of the Management Committee for Sugar,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The compensatory amounts for sugar applicable during the 1974/75 sugar marketing year in trade between the Community as originally constituted and the new Member States, in trade between the new Member States themselves as well as between the new Member States and third countries:

- (a) shall be fixed for the products listed in Annex I in the manner indicated in that Annex;
- (b) shall be obtained in respect of the products in Article 1 (1) (d) of Regulation No 1009/67/EEC by multiplying the basic compensatory amount indicated in Annex II by the sucrose content inclusive of the content of other sugars expressed in sucrose of the product in question.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 July 1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
