

**REGULATION (EEC) No 17/74 OF THE COMMISSION****of 3 January 1974****fixing the levies on rice and broken rice**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC<sup>(1)</sup> of 25 July 1967 on the common organization of the market in rice, as last amended by the Act<sup>(2)</sup> annexed to the Treaty<sup>(3)</sup> on the Accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972, and in particular Article 11 (5) thereof;

Having regard to the Opinion of the Monetary Committee;

Whereas the import levies on rice and broken rice were fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 2365/73<sup>(4)</sup> and subsequent amending Regulations;

Whereas, if the levy system is to operate normally, levies should be calculated on the following basis:

- in the case of currencies which are maintained in relation to each other, at any given moment, within a band of 2.25 %, a rate of exchange based on their effective parity;

- for other currencies an exchange rate based on the arithmetic mean of the spot market rates of each of these currencies recorded for a given period, in relation to the Community currencies referred to in the previous subparagraph;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 2365/73 to the offer prices and today's quotations known to the Commission that the levies at present in force should be altered as shown in the Table annexed to this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The import levies to be charged on the products listed in Article 1 (1) (a) and (b) of Regulation No 359/67/EEC are hereby fixed as shown in the Table annexed to this Regulation.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 4 January 1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
