**REGULATION (EEC) No 2063/74 OF THE COUNCIL**  
**of 1 August 1974**  
**amending Regulation (EEC) No 2829/72 on the Community quota for the**  
**carriage of goods by road between Member States**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 75 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament<sup>(1)</sup>;

Having regard to the Opinion of the Economic and Social Committee<sup>(2)</sup>;

Whereas, on the basis of the results of the examination of the developments since 1969 in the traffic of the new Member States, there are grounds for increasing the basic quotas of the Community authorizations which are allocated to them pursuant to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2829/72<sup>(3)</sup> of 28 December 1972 on the Community quota for the carriage of goods by road between Member States; whereas, moreover, taking into account the fact that the anticipated effects of the increase in trade consequent upon enlargement of the Community will be more acutely felt by carriers of the new Member States, provision should be made for an additional increase in the said basic quotas and the percentage, on the basis of which the quotas for 1974 were increased by the said Regulation, should be adapted in favour of those States,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Articles 3 and 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 2829/72 are hereby replaced by the following Articles with effect from 1 July 1974:

*'Article 3*

For the second half of 1974 the quota shall consist of 1 970 authorizations.

*Article 4*

For the second half of 1974 the number of Community authorizations allocated to each Member State shall be as follows:

Belgium	221,
Denmark	141,
Germany	356,
France	341,
Ireland	42,
Italy	266,
Luxembourg	58,
Netherlands	318,
United Kingdom	227.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
