

REGULATION (EEC) No 1990/75 OF THE COMMISSION**of 30 July 1975****authorizing the United Kingdom partially to suspend as regards certain products of the cereals and rice sector the component for the protection of the processing industry**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to the Act of Accession, and in particular Articles 59 (4) and 61 (3) thereof;

Whereas under Article 61 (3) of the Act the components for the protection of the processing industry (hereinafter called 'fixed components') are to be progressively abolished in trade between the Community as originally constituted and the new Member States and between the new Member States themselves by reductions to be made at the beginning of successive marketing years for the basic product concerned in accordance with the timetable laid down in Article 59 (1) of the Act; whereas, however, Article 59 (4) of the Act, which by virtue of Article 61 (3) of the Act applies to the fixed component, allows the new Member States wholly or partially to suspend such component;

Whereas the United Kingdom has requested authorization from the Commission partially to suspend the fixed component for certain products of the cereals and rice sector; whereas such measure seeks, by maintaining at the previous level in pounds sterling the amount of the fixed components for certain products,

to nullify the effect of applying in the cereals and rice sectors from the beginning of the 1975/76 marketing year the new representative rate for the pound sterling as fixed on 3 March 1975; whereas it appears appropriate to accede to this request;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The United Kingdom is hereby authorized in respect of the products listed in the Annex hereto so partially to suspend the fixed component applicable on imports from the other Member States as to reduce it for each such product to the amount indicated in the said Annex.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force:

- on 1 August 1975 for products covered by Regulation No 120/67/EEC,
- on 1 September 1975 for products covered by Regulation No 359/67/EEC.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
