

REGULATION (EEC) No 2371/75 OF THE COMMISSION
of 16 September 1975
establishing the standard average values for customs purposes of imported
citrus fruits

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community;

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No
1570/70⁽¹⁾ of 3 August 1970 establishing a system of
standard average values for citrus fruits, as last
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1937/74⁽²⁾ of 24
July 1974, and in particular Article 2 thereof;

Whereas it follows from the application of the notes
and criteria laid down by Regulation (EEC) No
1570/70 to the elements communicated to the
Commission in accordance with Article 4 (1) of that

Regulation that the standard average values should be
fixed as shown in the Annex to this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The standard average values provided for in Article 2
(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1570/70 shall be as shown
in the table in the Annex.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 19
September 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
