

REGULATION (EEC) No 2477/75 OF THE COMMISSION

of 29 September 1975

providing for greater flexibility in the arrangements governing the issue of import licences (EXIM) laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 in respect of the market in beef and veal

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68⁽¹⁾ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1855/74⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 21 (2) thereof;

Whereas, by way of protective measures in respect of beef and veal, arrangements for the issue of import licences following the prior exportation of beef and veal products were laid down in Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75⁽³⁾ of 23 April 1975, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2033/75⁽⁴⁾; whereas, although the state of the market in beef and veal is still a source of concern, a gradual return to a normal import system can be envisaged in view of the more stable situation which seems to be emerging;

Whereas, to that end, the rate of issue of import licences should be increased and the quantities of meat which may be imported doubled in relation to the quantities exported; provision also being made for the phasing of imports,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. Article 3(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 is hereby replaced by the following:

'1. On each occasion that products listed in Annex I, other than those sold in accordance with Regulations (EEC) No 2320/74 and (EEC) No 616/75, are exported without refund, two applications for import licences may be submitted with a view to the issue of two licences relating to identical quantities expressed as beef or veal in carcase; each of those quantities must not exceed the quantities exported or be less than 10 metric tons.

The applications shall be accompanied by a declaration indicating:

(a) the relevant quantities expressed in kilogrammes of beef or veal in carcase;

(b) the rate of the levy per 100 kilogrammes of beef or veal in carcase, identical for both licences, which the applicant undertakes to pay upon importation; the rate shall be expressed in the national currency of the Member State in which the applications are made.'

2. The first subparagraph of Article 3(2) and Article 3(3) of Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 are hereby repealed.

Article 2

Article 4(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 is hereby replaced by the following:

'1. Applications for import licences shall be submitted to the competent agencies in the Member States from the first to the seventh and from the sixteenth to the twenty-second day of each month.

In December, however, applications for licences may be submitted only during the first period mentioned in the preceding subparagraph.'

Article 3

Article 5(3) of Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 is hereby replaced by the following:

'3. The first of the two licences shall be issued on the fourteenth day following the first day of the period in which the applications were submitted. The second licence shall be issued the first day of the third month following that in which the applications were submitted.'

Article 4

In column 3 of Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75, the figure '60' listed against subheadings 02.01 A II a) 1 cc) 22 'Boned or boneless' and 02.01 A II a) 2 dd) 22 'Boned or boneless' is hereby replaced by the figure '80' in each case.

Article 5

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 October 1975.
