

REGULATION (EEC) No 3265/75 OF THE COMMISSION
of 15 December 1975

altering the monetary compensatory amounts applicable in the wine sector

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 974/71⁽¹⁾ of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture following the temporary widening of the margins of fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member States, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 475/75⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 6 thereof;

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts introduced by Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2719/75⁽³⁾ of 24 October 1975, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2896/75⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas from 16 December 1975 the new activating prices in the wine sector are applicable; whereas this must be taken into account in fixing the monetary compensatory amounts;

Whereas in calculating these amounts account must also be taken of the adjustment of the activating prices as a result of the new representative rates fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 475/75, which had been delayed until 16 December 1975 pursuant to Article 2 of the said Regulation;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Wine,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Part 6 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 2719/75 is replaced by Part 6 of the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 16 December 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
