

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1089/76**  
**of 11 May 1976**  
**amending Regulation (EEC) No 363/76 fixing export refunds for raw tobacco**  
**from the 1975 crop**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European  
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No  
727/70 of 21 April 1970 on the common organization  
of the market in raw tobacco <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by  
the Act of Accession <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular the first  
sentence of the third subparagraph of Article 9 (2)  
thereof,

Whereas export refunds were fixed for certain varieties  
of tobacco from the 1975 crop by Commission Regula-  
tion (EEC) No 363/76 of 19 February 1976 <sup>(3)</sup>;

Whereas new export outlets have arisen for certain  
varieties since Regulation (EEC) No 363/76 came into  
effect; whereas the list of countries of destination  
should be extended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation  
are in accordance with the opinion of the Manage-  
ment Committee for Raw Tobacco,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

In the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 363/76, under  
serial numbers 15, 16 and 17, there is hereby added  
the following country of destination: 'Republic of  
South Africa'.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day  
following its publication in the *Official Journal of  
the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
