

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 180/76

of 28 January 1976

concerning an invitation to tender for the costs of delivery of skimmed-milk powder to the United Republic of Tanzania as food aid

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 740/75⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (5) thereof,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1348/75 of 26 May 1975 on the supply of skimmed-milk powder as food aid to certain developing countries and international organizations under the 1975 programme⁽³⁾, provides *inter alia* for the supply of 2 000 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder to the United Republic of Tanzania; whereas this country has requested the supply of the abovementioned quantity;

Whereas according to Article 5 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1347/75 of 26 May 1975 laying down general rules for the supply of skimmed-milk powder as food aid to certain developing countries and international organizations under the 1975 programme⁽⁴⁾, the delivery costs for this quantity shall be the subject of a tendering procedure;

Whereas the tendering procedure should essentially be that laid down by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2557/74 of 4 October 1974 concerning an invitation to tender for the costs of delivery, as food aid, of skimmed-milk powder to certain third countries⁽⁵⁾, for the 1974 food-aid programme; whereas it is however necessary to specify certain points, in particular the time limit for the submission of tenders and the conditions governing the delivery of skimmed-milk powder;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

Article 1

1. In accordance with the provisions of Regulations (EEC) No 1347/75 and (EEC) No 1348/75, tenders shall be invited for the costs of delivery of a lot of 2 000 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder for the United Republic of Tanzania.

2. Subject to the special provisions contained hereinafter, the provisions of Regulation (EEC) No 2557/74 shall apply to the tendering procedure and to the terms for delivery of the skimmed-milk powder.

Article 2

1. The skimmed-milk powder shall be collected from the Irish intervention agency.

2. The Irish intervention agency shall have the packing marked, in letters at least one centimetre high, as follows: 'Skimmed-milk powder — Gift of the European Economic Community to the United Republic of Tanzania — For free distribution'.

Article 3

1. The port of embarkation indicated in the tender shall be chosen from among ports in the Community accessible for ocean-going ships having a regular service to the country of destination.

2. Delivery shall be effected on dates to be fixed by the intervention agency concerned which must be:

- for 400 metric tons after 1 and before 20 March 1976,
- for 500 metric tons after 1 and before 20 April 1976,
- for 600 metric tons after 1 and before 20 May 1976,
- for 500 metric tons after 1 and before 20 June 1976.

Article 4

The intervention agency may pay by instalments upon presentation of the taking over certificate applying to a partial supply as specified in Article 3.

Article 5

The time limit for the submission of tenders is 10 February 1976 at 12 noon.

Article 6

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
